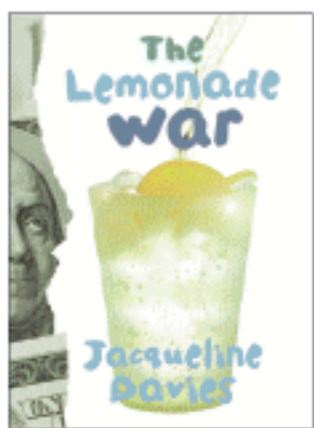

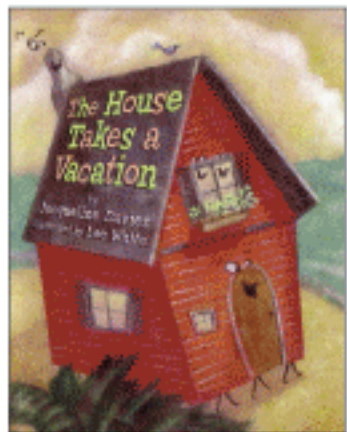


### The Lemonade War

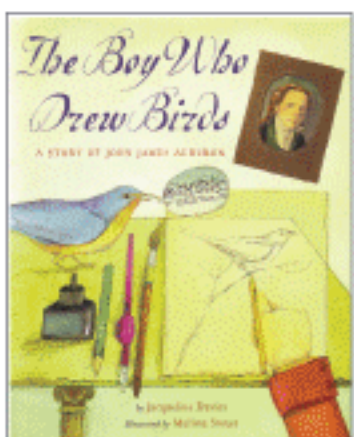


### The Night Is Singing

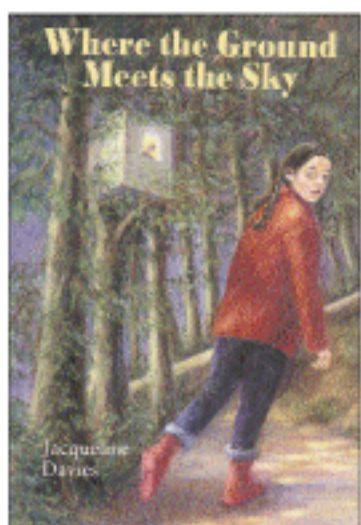


### The Boy Who Drew Birds: A Story of John James Audubon
